SPEED LIMIT REDUCED AT NERANWOOD

The speed limit on Gold Coast–Springbrook Road at Neranwood will change next month (December) in response to community concerns.

Transport and Main Roads (TMR) South Coast Regional Director Paul Noonan said a speed limit review had been completed.

"We've listened to the community and the Speed Management Committee has undertaken a speed limit review," Mr Noonan said

"The review process considers a range of factors such as road function, roadside environment, road construction standards, prevailing traffic speeds and crash history.

"In consideration of these factors, the committee's recommendation is to permanently reduce the speed limit from 80km/h to 70km/h on a five-kilometre section, from 200 metres south of Johns Road to 100 metres north of Mount Nimmel Road.

"The committee includes representatives from the Queensland Police Service, Gold Coast City Council and the Department of Transport and Main Roads.

"Speed limits are in place to improve safety for all road users.

"I urge all motorists to observe the new speed limit signs and to always drive to conditions."
