



Event Traffic Marshal eLearn

Overview

The Event Traffic Marshal eLearn program is designed to provide event volunteers with knowledge and skills in basic traffic control on the roads around special events, such as fetes, festivals, marathons, fun runs/walks and sporting events.

Successful completion of the program is a pre-requisite for a volunteer to be appointed as an Event Traffic Marshal at the special event. (# see below note on exemption).

The program is designed to be completed by an individual progressing through it at their own pace, rather than by people in a group setting.

Program structure

There are two (2) parts to the Event Traffic Marshal program.

Part 1: Event Traffic Marshal Eligibility check

The eligibility check is a short set of questions that participants **MUST** complete before gaining access to Part 2 of the program.

This eligibility check is designed to ensure that participants are aware of the physical fitness and suitability requirements for the role, and that only participants who indicate they meet these requirements proceed to Part 2 of the program.

Part 2: Event Traffic Marshal eLearn

This short training module will allow participants to gain the skills and knowledge to carry out traffic control as an Event Traffic Marshal at special events.

Program outcomes

On completion of this program participants will:

- be able to recognise if they meet the fitness for duty and physical capability requirements to be engaged as an Event Traffic Marshal
- gain a clear insight into their role and obligations as an Event Traffic Marshal
- know how to carry out Event Traffic Marshal duties in a safe, compliant and professional manner, including knowing the different hand and STOP/SLOW bat signals required to control traffic movement on the roads around a special event.

To receive a Certificate of Completion, the participant must complete the quiz in part 2 of the program and receive a 100% pass mark.

Target audience

- Volunteers who wish to support community events to be engaged as an Event Traffic Marshal.
- People who have been engaged as a Event Traffic Marshal previously and wish to refresh their knowledge of the role and responsibilities.

Program Prerequisites

NIL for undertaking the eLearn program.

Pre-requisites for becoming an Event Traffic Marshal are detailed in the program.

Duration

As this is a self-paced program, completion times will vary from person to person. Participants should allow between 20 and 90 minutes.

Program content

- eligibility check
- roles and responsibilities of Event Traffic Marshal and Event Organiser
- common hazards when carrying out traffic control duties as an Event Traffic Marshal
- playing it safe when carrying out traffic control duties as an Event Traffic Marshal
- how to control traffic.

Note on exemption: Completion of this eLearn program is not a requirement to be appointed as an Event Traffic Marshal for a special event, if the person can provide evidence to the Event Organiser that they have been appointed as an Event Traffic Marshal in the previous 12 month period.
